2. Recognition and detection of weapons, dangerous substances and devices.
3. Recognition on a non-discriminatory basis of characteristics and behavioral patterns of persons who are likely to threaten security.
4. Techniques used to circumvent security measures.
5. A structured approach towards effective communication and co-operation with any personnel involved in the application of the Port Facility Security Plan.
6. Methodology of drill and exercising of the Port Facility Security Plan.

### **1.3. Course Objectives**

Those who successfully complete this course should be able to undertake the duties and responsibilities as Port Facility Personnel and apply the knowledge and or training listed in the ISPS-Code Part A art. 18 (Part B/18.3).
